

Cat Supply Checklist

Are you prepared to bring your new family addition home? The Good Mews Animal Foundation has compiled a checklist of all the items you will need to help make the introduction of your new cat a success!

- Unscented Litter (we have been using the "Clumping" kind for the adult cats, regular Clay litter for the kittens)
- Litter box (1 for each cat in your household)
- Litter Scoop
- Dry Cat Food (Kittens are on Science Diet Kitten Formula, Adults are on Science Diet Adult Maintenance)
- Toys (Interactive toys e.g. feathers and laser lights and other toys e.g. regular balls and furry mice)
- Tall, sturdy scratching post (sisal weaves are the most effective, sisal rope is next, then carpet). The post must be tall enough for your cat to stretch up on and must not be wobbly when the cat rubs against it. We recommend "The World's Best Scratching Post" available at The Cat Clinic of Roswell (full money back guarantee). For more information, call them at 770-552-PURR (7877)
- Stainless steel or ceramic food and water bowls
- Brush/Comb
- Cat Bed/Window Perch
- Tartar control cat treats
- Break-away collar
- ID Tag (you can make one of these at most PetsMart stores)
- Carrier (hard sided preferred)
- Nail clippers for trimming cat's claws

G.R.A.S.P. does NOT recommend the following items as they can lead to behavioral/health problems:

- Litter boxes with hoods
- Litter box plastic liners
- Scented litter
- Plastic food and water bowls
- Collars without a break-away safety latch
- Canned cat food (other than as a treat)

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
